Role Description: Team Manager

Qualifications: Typically the parent of a team member who is willing to attend matches and take responsibility for the team when Coaches are unavailable. Experience in netball will vary from none to active playing experience. The scope of the individual role will depend on the level of experience and should be reviewed with the Head Coach.

Responsible to: Head Coach

Responsibilities:

- Attend training sessions for your team each week if you can and assist the Coach with practices.
- Accompany team to matches as required, taking balls, bibs, first aid and documentation provided by the Coach.
- In consultation with the team and any guidance which has been left by the Coach, decide which players will play in each play period and allocate positions.
- Be responsible for the basic first aid and welfare of players and record incidents on a Club Incident Report form.
- Ensure that correctly completed player sheets are handed at after each match.
- Note the final score and report back to the coach.
- Pay Umpire as necessary.
- Return the balls, bibs etc to the Coach as soon as possible after the match.
- Maintain high standards of ethical sportsmanship when interacting with players, officials and the opposition. If anyone behaves badly do not do the same or encourage your team to depart from fair play. Report issues to the Club's Head Coach in the first instance.
